


Acute Appendicitis

CT scans of two separate patients with acute appendicitis.

In the upper image there is a single calcified appendicolith visible near the base of the appendix (arrowed); the appendix is dilated but with minimal fat stranding adjacent.

In the lower image there are several small appendicoliths in an inflamed appendix with adjacent fat stranding. An appendicolith is a faecolith within the appendix lumen.
