Right: An arterial phase axial CT of a cyclist who fell from her bicycle onto the handlebars causing disruption of the right lobe of the liver which resolved with non-operative management.



Below: Arterial (left) and portal phase axial CT images of another patient who suffered blunt trauma resulting in a laceration/contusion of the right lobe with a pseudoaneurysm and extravasation (black arrow). The images at the bottom show subsequent angiography and coiling of the bleeding vessel.
